- 1) Who has the ultimate authority in the polling place? \_\_\_\_\_

- 5) Is a notice regarding use of wireless or recording devices required to be posted where voters are waiting to vote? \_\_\_\_\_

- 13) Are voters allowed to bring in campaign materials that may assist them in casting their ballot? \_\_\_\_\_
- 14) Can poll workers allow voters to vote their ballot using their cell phones in the polling place? \_\_\_\_\_
- 15) Are candidates allowed to give voters a ride to the polling place? \_\_\_\_\_
- 16) How many election officials are required to render assistance to a voter who is eligible for assistance on election day? \_\_\_\_\_
- 17) Can a voter bring anyone they want to assist them with voting? \_\_\_\_\_
- 18) Are voters that have mobility issues able to request to move to the front of the line for voting? \_\_\_\_\_
- 19) Who is eligible for curbside voting? \_\_\_\_\_
- 20) If a voter has a ballot by mail with them when they come to vote and surrenders it to the poll worker, are they required to vote provisionally? \_\_\_\_\_
