1. County Commissioner for Precinct 2, Karl Bookter, called the meeting to order at 8:38 AM for the purpose of canvassing the votes from the General Election held on November 7th, 2006

Michael Benton reported to the Court that the totals number of votes cast in the November 7th, 2006 General Election was 21,792 votes by the Tom Green county voters.

Commissioner Easingwood moved to accept the canvass of the General Election held November 7th, 2006 and certify to the canvass held on November the 17th, 2006 at 8:30 AM in the Tom Green County Commissioners' Court Room. Commissioner Hoelscher seconded the motion. The motion passed 3-0. (Recorded with these Minutes.)
